 - Mussel surveys scheduled for September 15 – 30, 2015.

 - Three separate plant surveys scheduled for 2016:
 - a. Early Spring (April 15 – 30, 2016): An early spring survey will target the end of the snow trillium blooming season, the end of the period when leaves of crane-fly orchids are most apparent, and the beginning of the period when white trout lily is in bloom.
 - b. Mid-Spring (May 15 – 30, 2016): A mid spring survey will target the end of the white trout lily bloom, as well as the prime blooming period for purple rocket and blue false-indigo.
 - c. Late Summer 2016: A late summer survey is targeted to be concurrent with the prime blooming period of rock skullcap, but will also allow surveyors to locate small whorled pogonia (if surveys are required) and blooming individuals of crane-fly orchids.

c. Engineering

- i. Preliminary HDD Design complete for the H-316 and H-318.
- ii. HDD geotechnical bores are complete. Geotechnical analysis reports are underway.
- iii. Preliminary design of Launchers and Receivers has commenced.
- iv. CP Groundbed site review complete.
- v. Preliminary alignment sheets for pipelines under review.

II. Compressor Station

a. Redhook Station (H-316 milepost 0.0)

 - Negotiations with landowners surrounding the proposed site ongoing with options pending.
- ii. Environmental – Steam and wetland surveys completed. Cultural surveys are complete

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- iii. Engineering – Compressor Station design on-going with two centrifugal and two reciprocating compressor units.
 - Preliminary Compressor Station plot plans and process flow diagrams are complete.
 - Cut and fill analysis complete to incorporate latest proposed plot plan.
 - Centrifugal compression units have been ordered.
 - Additional compression and other equipment initial quotes are on-going.
 - Preliminary emissions evaluation for the site is underway.
 - Baseline noise study complete in July. Air quality and noise modeling efforts currently underway.
 - Property line surveys complete in July.
- iv. Construction – Station site has been reviewed for constructability and found acceptable.

- i. Land – An Interconnect location has been identified. Permission to survey site obtained and negotiating option for site.
