It is a new 24-inch pipeline extension, approximately 550 feet in length that will move gas from the Redhook Compressor Station to Equitrans' existing H-305 pipeline located at the Braden Run Interconnect with Texas Eastern.
 - 100% routing complete for proposed route
 - 100% survey permissions obtained for proposed route
 - 0% centerline survey complete for proposed route
 - 0% ROW acquired by length

- vi. H-319 (0.04 mi)
 - The H-319 pipeline was added to the Equitrans Expansion Project in July 2015. It is a new 16-inch pipeline, approximately 200 feet in length that will connect the Equitrans H-306 pipeline to the Webster Interconnect with the Mountain Valley Pipeline.
 - 100% routing complete for proposed route
 - 100% survey permissions obtained for proposed route
 - 0% centerline survey complete for proposed route
 - 0% ROW acquired by length
 - 1 access road identified to date, 0% acquired
 - 1 ancillary site identified to date, 0% acquired

II. Compressor Station

 - 10-day letter being prepared for one landowner to facilitate property access for upcoming geotechnical investigations, cultural and biological surveys.

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- ii. Environmental – Steam and wetland surveys completed. Cultural surveys are underway and threatened and endangered species surveys will commence in August.
- iii. Engineering – Compressor Station design on-going with two centrifugal and two reciprocating compressor units.
 - Preliminary Compressor Station plot plans and process flow diagrams are complete.
 - Cut and fill analysis ongoing to incorporate latest proposed plot plan.
 - Centrifugal compression units have been ordered.
 - Additional compression and other equipment initial quotes are on-going.
 - Preliminary emissions evaluation for the site is underway.
 - Baseline noise study completed in July. Air quality and noise modeling efforts currently underway.
 - Property line surveys completed in July.
- iv. Construction – Station site has been reviewed for constructability and found acceptable.

III. Interconnect Facility

a. Webster Interconnect

- i. Land – An Interconnect location has been identified. Permission to survey site obtained and negotiating option for site.
- ii. Environmental – Wetlands and steams surveys complete. Cultural surveys will be completed in August.
