FEDERAL AND STATE AUTHORIZATIONS

FERC issued a partial Notice to Proceed on January 30, 2018 for the Mobley Tap and Webster Interconnect facilities.

CONSTRUCTION STATUS

Tables 1 and 2 provide status updates for each facility by construction activity. Values are generated per contractor and inspection status reports prior to reconciliation, which may generate minor inconsistencies.
